## Leaving a Legacy to Trinity College Dublin

## Information for Irish donors

To ensure a gift can be efficiently transferred to the University, we suggest the following sample wording for inclusion in a will. Please note sample formats are for information purposes only. We recommend that you consult your solicitor to advise you in light of your own circumstances.



## 'I give the...

- » whole (or a % share) of the residue of my estate (for a residual gift)
- » the sum of € (in figures and words) (for a pecuniary gift)
- » my (full description of item and its location) (for a gift of an asset or shares)

...to Trinity College Dublin (Charity Number CHY10898) to be used for the general charitable purposes of Trinity College Dublin.

I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer of Trinity College shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executor(s)'.

If you wish to make a gift to a specific area or School in Trinity College Dublin, please amend the clause accordingly. We recommend that you contact us, in confidence, to discuss your intentions and to ensure that we understand and can act on your wishes. Trinity College Dublin has charitable status and thus your legacy will be exempt from inheritance tax.
